We engaged in talks and discussions about renters rights, abortions, our relationships with the Trade Unions on Campus as well as engaging in a rapid fire simulation of a Students' Union.

I also attended the Campaigns Workshop set up by NUS-USI to assess how we bring our constituents into the regional/national campaigns.

I also attended a series of meetings within the university which were largely about meeting the new team, and also worked with the UCU and Unite to address issues at the Health and Safety Committee.
