

Undergraduate Education Officer Report

July

- **All officer training** happened in June before our role began. This was over a four day period and Queens specific.
- **USI Student Union** Training took place in Tralee and was over a five day period this helped form connections and a network with Union of Students in Ireland.
- Represented students at **Graduation ceremonies**.
- Met with **various staff members to discuss** my priorities for the year ahead.
- The team held banner painting a few days prior to **pride parade** along with attending the pride picnic that was run by queens. This was well attended and brought together a sense of community in the lead up to pride. I attended pride parade with the other officers this was a very well attended event with NUS-USI providing breakfast before this event.
- I got trained up on what occurred last year in regard to the **academic rep review**. I went out to each school and asked them to nominate a Student Rep Coordinator. This role is part of the code of practice and gives a direct link between the university and SU. All 15 schools nominated a School Rep Coordinator, and we made a team's channel for bringing together a community of practice.
- Worked with the with the team in our response to the **bar price increase**. After discussions with the university, we reversed the prices and came to a new agreement on what prices were manageable for students.
- Confirmed the status of **commercial services forum** and that finances should be set out clearly during these meetings.
