Over the past year, I have introduced a comprehensive drug harm reduction programme to Queen's and pushed for consent training to be part of the welcome experience. I have consistently fought to make students' lives better and achieve radical change, now I'm asking for your vote so I can fight for you again.

Consent Training for All

Consent is mandatory so training shouldn't be optional. All students should be given comprehensive and inclusive consent training that is based on their needs.



Fight for Student Renters

There is a student housing crisis in Belfast. Prices are skyrocketing and many are living in appalling conditions. Landlords think they can get away with treating us like this. It's time to prove them wrong.

We need to introduce property-rating and accreditation schemes that push landlords to improve conditions. The long term solution is investment in a student housing co-operative programme that will give students control over their own housing.

Drug Harm Reduction

Students shouldn't be demonised for their drug use. A drug harm reduction approach moves the university away from punishment to a wellbeing-focused response.

A Safer Campus

Student safety on and off campus should be a priority. The university should partner with a personal safety app such as Safezone and provide personal safety alarms.
