1. Competition Dates

1.1 The competition runs from 10am, Monday 2 March to 5pm, Thursday 5 March 2026

2. Prize

3.1 Vote in the SU Elections 2026 via q-su.org between 2-5 March 2026

3.2 Voting in Clubs & Societies Elections alone does not qualify. Only one entry per person.

3.3 One entry per person.

3.4 No purchase necessary.

4. Winner Selection & Notification

4.1 The Accommodation Site with the highest percentage of votes upon close of voting will win the prize.
