Terms & Conditions

Graduation Package Prize Draw – Open to All Students

1. The competition is open from 10am, Monday 4 March, 2024
The closing date for receipt of entries is 3pm, Thursday 7 March, 2024
A prize draw will take place on Monday 11 March, 2024
2. **1 x GRADUATION PACKAGE (WORTH TO THE VALUE OF £350):**
 - Visit Belfast Food & Drink Voucher (worth £130) – voucher of which will be available for collection by winner
 - Graduate Family Photography Package (worth £70) – voucher of which will be available for collection by winner

 - Gown Hire + 2 x Extra Garden Party Tickets (worth £80) – amount of which will be sent via bank transfer to winner
 - Class Hoodie (worth £45.95) – amount of which will be sent to winner via bank transfer to winner
3. To enter the prize draw, entrants must vote in the SU Elections 2024, held from 10am, 4 March 2024 – 3pm, 7 March 2024. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website (<http://www.q-su.org/>).
4. Solely voting in the Clubs & Societies Committee Elections does **NOT** constitute voting in the SU Elections, and does not provide an entry to this competition.
5. To be eligible for the prize the winner must:
 - hold a UK bank account in order for the prize money to be transferred
 - be over the age of eighteen on the closing date
 - be a current member of Queen's Students' Union (St Mary's, Stranmillis and Queen's-INTO students are not eligible)
 - be a final year Undergraduate Student or a Postgraduate Taught / Postgraduate Research Student who will be graduating in the Summer 2024 or Winter 2024 cohorts
6. The prize draw includes students who are undertaking sub-degree level one (or two) year professional development certificate programmes however the prize will be altered depending on the winner's Graduation Ceremony Status
7. The prize draw excludes permanent employees and their immediate families of Queen's Students Union, Queen's University, Belfast, their agents or anyone professionally connected with this promotion.
8. Queen's Students' Union reserves the right to request proof of age and sight of a valid Queen's University student card.
9. The prize is only redeemable against Summer 2024 or Winter 2024 graduations and will not be able to be transferred to other graduations regardless of reason: eg delayed module/s, undertaking of placement, withdrawal from course, deferment or unsuccessful completion etc

10. For your total confidence, the winner of the Individual Student prize will be selected at random by an independent third party along with a list of reserve winners.
11. Winners will be notified via the QUB e-mail address details collected via the voting system. Winners should respond in the manner outlined and within the time specified in the e-mail to claim the prize. If a winner does not respond within the time specified we will award the prize to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. This process will be repeated until a winner redeems the prize. Should prize notification/s be returned as undeliverable we will award the prize/s to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.

13. Entries from third parties or agents or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made directly by the person entering the promotion.
