

Queen's Students' Union - SU Elections 2026

Graduation Package – Terms & Conditions

1. Competition Dates

1.1 The competition runs from **10am, Monday 2 March to 5pm, Thursday 5 March 2026.**

1.2 The prize draw will take place the week commencing **Monday 9 March 2026.**

2. Prize

2.1 **1x Graduation Package (Worth up to £350) includes:**

- £150 Visit Belfast Food & Drink Voucher.
- £83 Graduate Family Photography Package.
- £47 Gown Hire + 2 Extra Garden Party Tickets (paid via bank transfer).
- £49.95 Class Hoodie (paid via bank transfer).
- Photography Postage fees: UK £7, Ireland £15, Europe £15, Rest of World £25.

2.2 The winner must have a UK bank account for the transfer.

2.3 The prize is non-transferable.

3. How to Enter

3.1 Vote in the SU Elections 2026 via q-su.org between 2-5 March 2026.

3.2 Voting in Clubs & Societies Elections alone does not qualify.

3.3 One entry per person.

3.4 No purchase necessary.

4. Winner Selection & Notification

4.1 A winner is randomly selected by an independent third party.

4.2 The winner will be contacted via QUB email.

4.3 If the winner does not respond within the given timeframe, a reserve winner will be chosen.

4.4 If prize notification is undeliverable, a substitute winner will be selected.

4.5 Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.

5. Eligibility

5.1 Open to current QSU students who are eligible to vote in the 2026 SU Election (excluding St Mary's and Stranmillis).

5.2 The winner must be a final year Undergraduate Student or a Postgraduate Taught /Postgraduate Research Student who will be graduating in the Summer 2026 or Winter 2026 cohorts

5.3 QSU reserves the right to request proof of age and a valid QUB student card.

5.4. The prize draw includes students who are undertaking sub-degree level one (or two) year professional development certificate programmes however the prize will be altered depending on the winner's Graduation Ceremony Status.

5.5 Employees of QSU and QUB, their families, and those professionally connected to the competition are not eligible.

6. Overseas Entrants

6.1 Winners outside the UK may receive a substitute prize if delivery is not possible. Cash prizes may incur banking or currency fees, which the winner must bear. By entering, winners accept that Northern Ireland law governs the competition and any disputes are resolved exclusively in its courts.
